To Our Valued Residents, Families and Representatives:

We recently received confirmation that a staff member in our facility tested positive for COVID-19. We have been in contact with the health authorities and are working closely with them to prevent further spread of the virus in our facility.

While we are disappointed that we have a staff member with COVID after we have worked so hard to prevent the spread of this virus in our facility, we know that we are dealing with an extremely contagious virus. Rather than be discouraged by this, we are going to focus our efforts on taking all necessary steps to protect our residents and staff.

We are committed to stopping the spread of this virus and we will continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required, and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community.
